4. FALL FOURTH DEGREE EXEMPLIFICATION.

The Fall Exemplification will take place Saturday, October 29, 2022, at All Saints Catholic Church (9300 Stonewall Rd, Manassas, VA 20110). Candidates should meet the Faithful Navigator at All Saints no later than 11:30 AM. Candidates muster no later than 11:30 AM in antechamber. The ceremony starts at 1:00 PM. The cost for each Candidate is \$70.00.

A Ladies Program will take place during the Exemplification, starting at about 11:15 AM. Details pending. A buffet Luncheon for candidates, Sir Knights, and Ladies follows at the George Brent Council Home (starts 2:30 – 3:00 PM). The Council home is on the church campus. Cost for observers and guests is \$25 per ticket. An optional Mass follows at 5:00 PM at All Saints.

Candidates are asked to wear a dark black, gray, or blue suit with plain white dress shirt, and a basic/conservative style tie. Both jacket and pants should be dark, and should match.

No brown or green suits, and no lapel pins. Candidates will receive Social Baldrick and a PG-113 pin. ACTIVE-DUTY military personnel may wear Class A dress uniform.

4th Degree Sir Knights may wear Official Regalia Dress or dark suit with Social Baldrick; PG-113 must be worn on lapel pin (NO other lapel pins!). Escorts need ORD—Service (with sword).

This is great opportunity for a local 4th Degree Exemplification. All 3rd Degree Knights are invited to step up!
